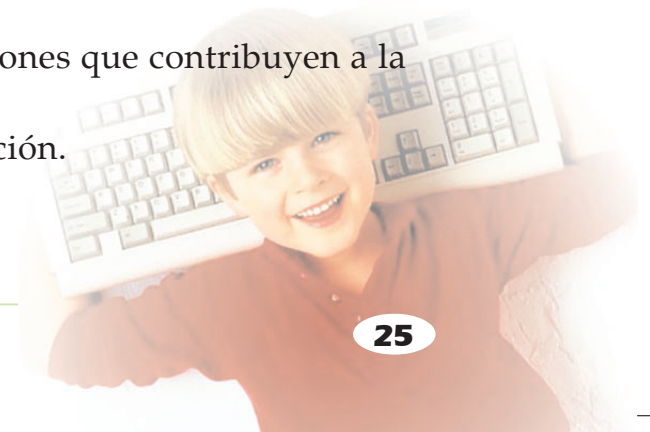
FIRST CONDITIONAL IF ONE DAY

If One Day...

If one day you feel like crying...
 Call me.
I don't promise that I will make you laugh,
 but I can cry with you.
If one day you want to run away—
 don't be afraid to call me.
I don't promise to ask you to stop...
 But I can run with you.
If one day you don't want to listen
 to anyone...
 Call me.
I promise to be there for you.
And I promise to be very quiet.
 But if one day you call...
 And there is no answer...
 Come fast to see me.
 Perhaps I need you.

LET'S LEARN AND PRACTICE

I write the following ideas on my notebook, I use the dictionary.

FIRST CONDITIONAL

You use the first conditional IF when:

- 1. Real situation:** You mention situations that happen often
Ex: Cecilia comes to your party, if she finishes her homework soon
- 2. Unreal Situation:** You mention situations that probably will happen in the future
Ex: If I pass my test with high scores, I will study at the university

Conditional sentences have two clauses:



CONDITION (If clause)

If you get up late
If I need you
If you don't study
If Mary doesn't come on time

RESULT (result clause)

you will lose your first class
I call you
you don't pass the exam
she will lost the job

But you can find it in this way too.

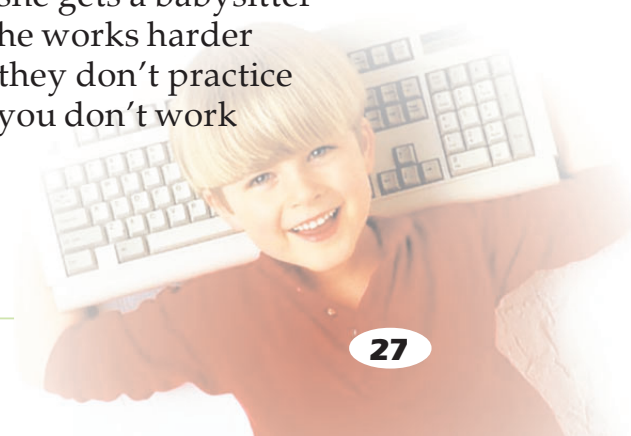


RESULT

Maria comes to the meeting
Juan doesn't fail the exams
They won't win the game
You won't get money

CONDITION

If she gets a babysitter
If he works harder
If they don't practice
If you don't work



FIRST CONDITIONAL

FORM: IF + SIMPLE PRESENT + WILL

Affirmative: If I get two tickets, I **will** invite you to the concert
We **will** go to Cartagena, **if** we save money.

Negative: If I **don't** get two tickets, I **won't** invite you to the concert
We **won't** go to Cartagena, **if** we don't save money.

Interrogative: What **will** you do **if** you don't get the tickets?
What **will** we do **if** we don't save money?

**WE DON'T USE WILL
IN THE CONDITIONAL
CLAUSES**

We can use the first conditional to express different function (which expresses a possible condition and a probable result)

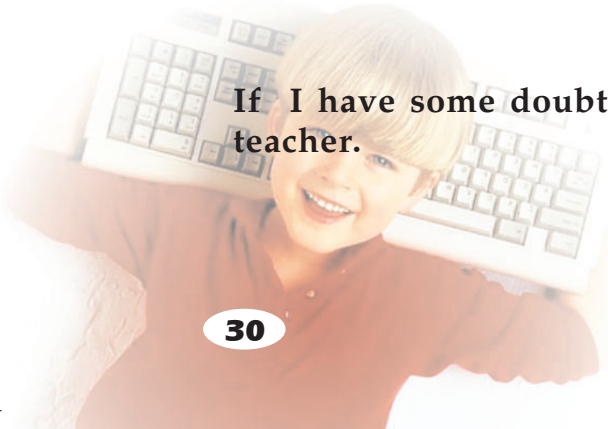
- If you do that I will kill you (threat)
- Careful! If you touch that, you will burn yourself. (warning)
- I will send you a postcard if you want (offer)
- If you lend me \$100.000, I will love you forever (promise)

Conditional: Unless

We use **UNLESS** with the meaning **If.....not**

I will go to your house **UNLESS** you have an appointment.

Jimmy will change his job **UNLESS** his boss gives him more money.

I will paint my room in black **UNLESS** my father doesn't let me.

We will go to the river **UNLESS** it rains.

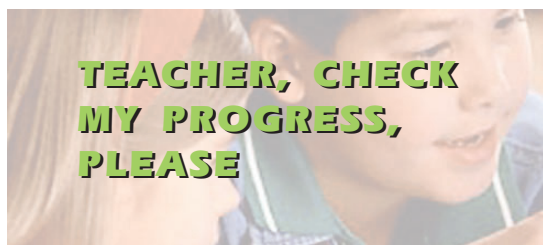

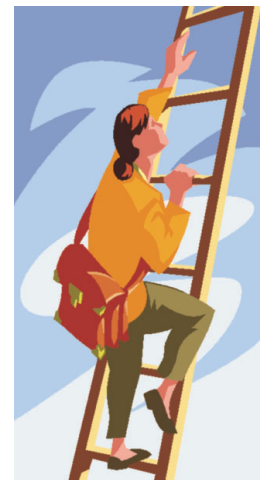




We read and analyze the following idea:
